#### **CHAPTER HISTORY**



1956 Chapter Meeting

Alpha Zeta Omega Chapter was chartered on April 14, 1928 by eight members of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® who desired to set up a chapter in Durham, North Carolina. Those members were Marjorie Shepard, Frances Eagleson, Bernice W. Jones, Jean Holtzclaw, Byrd Jackson, Beatrice Qualls Burnette, Aida Fortune and Gladys Powell. Vivian Mason, South Atlantic Regional Director established the chapter which remained a part of the South Atlantic Region until 1953.

Alpha Zeta Omega then became a part of the newly created Mid-Atlantic Region under the leadership of Dr. Rose Butler Browne, the first Mid-Atlantic

Regional Director and a longtime member of the Alpha Zeta Omega Chapter as well as its 11th Chapter President.

#### The First

Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® was **the first** Greek-letter organization established by African American college-educated women on January 15, 1908 on the campus of Howard University.

Alpha Zeta Omega was **the first** Greek-letter Sorority in the city of Durham and the third chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated ® to be established in the state of North Carolina.

#### Service and Scholarships

The current membership of Alpha Zeta Omega includes over 400 talented and professional women who represent high ethical and moral standards. Our chapter has a long legacy of promoting and upholding the policies, initiatives and programs of Alpha

Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® as envisioned by our founders and charter members - To be of service to those within the Durham community. Our cornerstone programs over the years have included, The Links to Learning Program - serving approximately 100 middle school students and their guardians, Emerging Young Leaders (EYL) - an after-school tutorial program for middle school students, **A.S.C.E.N.D.** - an academic and life skills training program for high school students focused on **A**chievement, **S**elf-Awareness, **C**ommunication, **E**ngagement,

**N**etworking and **D**evelopmental Skills with an emphasis on SMART careers (science, math and related technologies), Youth Leadership Institute (YLI) - a leadership development initiative for 11-13 year olds, and the annual scholarship program highlighted through our **Debutante Cotillion Program.** 

#### **Debutante Cotillion**

Since 1991, the Alpha Zeta Omega Chapter has sponsored the Debutante Cotillion Program to provide activities and opportunities that will assist in empowering young ladies to be successful during their transition from high school to post-secondary education. To date, more than 600 young ladies have participated in the program, including 10 from 2023, with hundreds of thousands of dollars raised for their post-secondary education.

Other initiatives of the Chapter have included programs for the community focusing on economic/financial literacy, promoting breast cancer and heart health awareness, voter registration and mobilization programs, entrepreneurial workshops, and assisting families in becoming self-sufficient.

Annually, Alpha Zeta Omega makes contributions to organizations whose mission is consistent with our goals of providing services which enhance the quality of life for citizens of the Greater Durham area. Organizations that have received funding from our chapter include: Durham Crisis Response Center, Durham Rescue Mission, John Avery Boys & Girls Club, Meals on Wheels of Durham , Sickle Cell Foundation, National Council of Negro Women, Women in Action, Wounded Warrior Project, Community Health Coalition, UNCF, Merrick-Washington Magazine, and many more.

Since 1944, the Chapter has annually presented college scholarship awards to high school students in Durham. To date, over \$750,000 in college scholarship dollars have been awarded to local graduating seniors.

#### Ivy Community Center, Inc. The "Home" of Alpha Zeta Omega Chapter

Established in 1995, The Ivy Community Center, Inc. (ICC) is a 501(c)(3) tax exempt organization that executes targeted service and educational programs to enhance the quality of life for the Durham community. ICC is an inviting and safe place to offer sustainable programs and services for the Durham community. The ICC Board of Directors works in conjunction with the Alpha Zeta Omega Chapter to respond to the needs of the community.

#### The timeline to homeownership:

1994 - Chapter President Mattie Moss, appointed a Sorority House Committee, chaired by members Artelia Bryant and Ida Alexander, to investigate and explore the possibility of the chapter acquiring ownership of a building.

August 1995 - Chapter President Janeen Denson Gammage and Artelia Bryant filed the Articles of Incorporation with the Office of the Secretary of State in Raleigh, NC.

January 1996 - the Internal Revenue Service granted the Corporation tax-exempt status.

February 2004 - Grand Opening and official dedication of the 7000 square feet facility (Ivy Community Center) located at 4418 Fayetteville Street, Durham, NC.

March 2009 - Celebration of the construction of the new 8500 square feet facility located at 4222 Fayetteville Road, Durham, NC (current location and facility).






